

## **Deputy Compliance Manager (Technical)**

Titan Airways is looking for a Deputy Compliance Manager (Technical) to join the Safety Team based at London Stansted. Reporting to the Director of Safety, the main responsibilities of the role will be the supervision and execution of the compliance monitoring program. Our airline operates multiple types of Airbus and Boeing aircraft in several challenging environments and VIP / ACMI contracts often at short notice. This role would suit an individual who can work well in a team setting, but with the initiative and confidence working on solo projects.

Key functions include:

- Deputising for the Director of Safety.
- Ensure that responsible Senior Management and if necessary, the Accountable Manager, are made aware of audit findings, or any significant issues arising from the CMS.
- Dissemination and communication of audit results and safety trends and requesting additional training if required.
- Using investigation findings to reduce the possibility of recurrence by requesting corrective / preventative action.
- Review policies and procedures established by Engineering to verify their clarity and coordination with the corporate policies and procedures, thus ensuring effective cross departmental procedures involving flight, cabin and airport operations.
- Ensuring that the organisation's staff complies with approved procedures, as specified in the CAME and MOE.
- Ensuring that Titan Engineering staff, Pilots and all contracted maintenance organisations are appropriately approved and / or competent to carry out the tasks specified.
- Controlling and issuing Company authorisations and 'One Off' Certification Authorisations.
- Control and issue of Flight Crew Authorisations.
- Review proposed revisions to the CAME and MOE.
- Represent the Titan Airways Safety and Compliance Department in negotiations with the Regulatory Authority, as well as attend industry seminars and conferences associated with engineering safety management and human factors issues.
- Participation in accident and incident investigation teams as required.
- Liaise with the Regulatory Authorities.

### **The following requirements are essential for this role:**

- The ability to hold a Form 4 Regulatory Approval.
- 5 Years' Experience in a Compliance / Quality role.
- Experience with Boeing and Airbus aircraft such as General Familiarisation or Type endorsement.
- A graduate or post graduate qualification in either an Aviation Safety, Risk or Accident Investigation related subjects.
- Computer literate and able to use technology to aid in their everyday role.
- Ability to reside and work in the UK.
